Site IDs are numbered more or less west-to-east along Lake Spokane and on the Spokane River/Nine Mile Reservoir. The Coeur d'Alene waterway sites are numbered north-to-south along the eastern lakeshore, west-to-east along the Coeur d'Alene River, west-to-east along the St. Maries River, then south-to-north along the western lakeshore. Sites are identified by name and site ID in figures 3.3-2 through 3.3-8.

Developed Site – a site designated for recreation use providing amenities such as campsites, fire rings, tables, toilets, boat ramps, docks, shelters, trails, and so on.

Dispersed Site – a site not designated nor developed (no amenities are provided) where informal recreation use is occurring due to desirable conditions. This results in site impacts due to the concentration of use such as hunting, hiking, bird watching, photography, primitive camping, bank fishing, boating, swimming, OHVing, and picnicking.
